

IS JESUS JEHOVAH?

Introduction

This is a paper intended to show from the scripture alone how the name Jehovah/Yahweh is applied to Jesus. I will also give various other proofs of His deity. I will put the Old Testament verses in black and their New Testament counterparts in red for distinction and comparison

The Old Testament was translated into Greek by seventy Jewish scholars a little over two hundred years before Christ. The translation was called the "Septuagint". To translate the Hebrew word YHWH (Yahweh, Jehovah) the Jewish scholars used the Greek word "Kurios" which is translated "Lord" in English.

The application of Kurios ("Lord") as a title of Jesus in the Greek New Testament, especially in early creedal statements like "Jesus is Lord" (Rom 10:9; 1Cor 12:3), means that **Jesus is Jehovah**. This is clearly seen as we contrast O.T. quotes using the name of YHWH/ Jehovah with the name "Kurios" chosen by the Holy Spirit Himself for Jesus as the New Testament was written.

Please examine all the scriptures as a whole. I am trying to do as little commentary as possible in order to allow the scripture to speak for itself. I recognize completely the two-fold nature of Christ which speaks of his submission to the Father and His admission that The Father was greater than He, Himself. I recognize limitations that were placed on Christ as readily seen in the scriptures. However, one also has to deal with the totality of scriptures that indicate the equality of the person of Christ with the Father as Jehovah such as the attributes of deity ascribed to Jesus, statements made about Jesus by others, and Jesus' own statements concerning Himself and His relationship to His Father. To ignore this aspect of His person and nature is to inflict injury to the soul, causing one to trust in a different Jesus that cannot save, Jesus said, "Except you believe I am He, you shall die in your sins.

A mere man Jesus can't save. A mere angel Jesus can't save. Only the Lord/Kurios/Jehovah Jesus can save. He alone is the express image of God manifest in the flesh to be the Savior of the world.

What I am writing doesn't come near to giving all the scriptural evidence but it should lend itself to a solid rational for identifying Jesus as Jehovah God. The very name "Jehovah/Yahweh is closely connected to the idea of eternal self existence. (Ex. 3:14-15) Jehovah/Yahweh declares Himself to be God "Elohim" which is a plural noun which literally means "gods". There is no difference in the word "Elohim" when used for the true one God, than there is for the word "Elohim" when it is used for a plurality of gods. When Elohim/God commanded that Israel have no other elohim/gods before Him, the Hebrew words for both God and gods are identical as it is throughout the Old Testament.

In Deuteronomy 6:4 the scripture says: Hear, O, Israel. Jehovah our God/Elohim *is* one Jehovah. However it is interesting that the plural nature of Jehovah is seen in the Old testament in such places as:

Gen 1:26 And God/Elohim said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness:

Gen 11:5 **And Jehovah came down** to see the city and the tower which the sons of Adam had built. 6 **And Jehovah said**, Behold! The people is one and they all have one language. And this they begin to do. And now nothing which they have imagined to do will be restrained from them. 7 **Come, let Us go down and there confuse their language**, so that they cannot understand one another's speech. :8 **So Jehovah scattered them abroad** from that place upon the face of all the earth. And they quit building the city.

When one looks at the triadic proclamations of the holiness of God in the Old and New Testaments such as the use of "Holy, Holy, Holy" and the triads of praise to the "Father, Son, and Holy Spirit", there is no doubt in my mind as to the plural nature of God. It is a mystery indeed but very clear to the honest student. However, in this paper I am only dealing with scriptural evidence that Jesus is one of the persons in the godhead trinity called Jehovah.

Scripture Compared With Scripture Revealing Jesus Is Jehovah God

Jehovah is God. Jesus is Jehovah

Psa 45:6 **Your throne, O God**, is forever and ever; the staff of Your kingdom is a staff of righteousness. 7 You love righteousness, and hate wickedness; **therefore God, Your God, has anointed You** with the oil of gladness above Your fellows.)

The above scripture verse is applied to Jesus in Hebrews chapter one where He is called God by God.

Heb 1:8 But to the Son He says, "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever. A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. 9 You have loved righteousness and hated iniquity, therefore God, Your God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness above Your fellows."

Jehovah is Creator. Jesus is Jehovah

Psa 102:12 But thou, **O Jehovah/Yahweh**, shalt endure for ever; and thy remembrance unto all generations. 13 Thou shalt arise, *and* have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come. 14 For thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and favour the dust thereof. 15 So the heathen shall fear the name of **Jehovah/Yahweh**, and all the kings of the earth thy glory. 16 When **Jehovah/Yahweh** shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory. 17 He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer. 18 This shall be written for the generation to come: and the people which shall be created shall praise **Jehovah/Yahweh**. 19 For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did **Jehovah/Yahweh** behold the earth; 20 To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death; 21 To declare the name of **Jehovah/Yahweh** in Zion, and his praise in Jerusalem; Psa 102:22 When the people are gathered together, and the kingdoms, to serve **Jehovah/Yahweh**. 23 He weakened my strength in the way; he shortened my days. 24 I said, O my God, take me not away in the midst of my days: thy years *are* throughout all generations. **25 Of old hast thou laid the foundation of the earth: and the heavens are the work of thy hands. 26 They shall perish, but thou shalt endure: yea, all of them shall wax old like a garment; as a vesture shalt thou change them, and they shall be changed: 27 But thou art the same, and thy years shall have no end. 28 The children of thy servants shall continue, and their seed shall be established before thee.**

Heb 1:10 And, "You, Lord (speaking of Jesus- Jehovah/Yahweh in the OT), have laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the works of Your hands. 11 They shall perish, but You will remain. And they shall all become old as a garment, 12 and as a covering You shall fold them up, and they shall be changed. But You are the same, and Your years shall not fail." 13 But to which of the angels, did He say at any time, "Sit on My right hand until I make Your enemies Your footstool?" 14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for those who shall be heirs of salvation?

Jehovah was pierced by His own people. Jesus is Jehovah

Zec 12:8 In that day **Jehovah** shall defend around the people of Jerusalem. And it will be, he who is feeble among them at that day *shall be* like David; and the house of David *shall be* like God, like the Angel of Jehovah before them. Zec 12:9 And it shall be in that day I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem. And I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplication, **so that they will look on Me whom they have pierced;** and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him, like the bitter weeping over a first-born. Zechariah 12:10

Rev 1:4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia. Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is coming; and from the seven spirits which are before His throne; 5 even from Jesus Christ the faithful Witness, the First-born from the dead and the Ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, 6 and made us kings and priests to God and His Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. 7 **Behold, He comes with the clouds, and every eye will see Him, and those who pierced Him will see Him, and all the kindreds of the earth will wail because of Him.** Even so, Amen. 8 I am the Alpha and Omega, *the* Beginning and *the* Ending, says the Lord, who is and who was and who is to come, **the Almighty.**

Mat 24:30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: **and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn,** and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

Only Jehovah is to be worshipped. Jesus is Jehovah

Exo 34:14 For you shall worship no other god. For Jehovah, whose name is Jealous, *is* a jealous God;

Mat 4:10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, **Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God,** and him only shalt thou serve.

Jesus was worshipped at His birth

Mat 2:11 And coming into the house, they saw the child with Mary His mother. **And they fell down and worshiped Him.** And opening their treasures, they presented gifts to Him, gold and frankincense and myrrh.

Jesus was worshipped by people to which He ministered

Mat 8:2 And behold, **a leper came and worshiped him, saying, Lord,** if You will, You can make me clean. (There are numerous references like this in the gospel)

Jesus was worshipped after His resurrection

Mat 28:9 But as they were going to report to His disciples, behold, Jesus also met them, saying, Hail! And they came and **held Him by the feet and worshiped Him.**

The Father commanded all the angels to worship Jesus

Heb 1:5 For to which of the angels did He say at any time, "You are My Son, this day I have begotten You?" And again, "I will be to Him a Father, and He shall be to Me a Son?" 6 And again, when He brings in the First-born into the world, He says, **"And let all the angels of God worship Him."**

Jesus is worshipped in heaven by all the multitudes on equal level as the Father

Rev 5:11 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands; 12 Saying with a loud voice, **Worthy is the Lamb that was slain** to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing. 13 And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, **Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto Him that sits upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.** 14 And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four *and* twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever.

Jehovah must be called upon for salvation. Jesus is Jehovah.

Joe 2:32 **And it shall be, whoever shall call on the name of Jehovah shall be saved;** for salvation shall be in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem, as Jehovah has said, and in the remnant whom Jehovah shall call.

Rom 10:9 Because if you confess the Lord (Jehovah) Jesus, and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from *the* dead, you shall be saved. 10 For with *the* heart *one* believes unto righteousness, and with *the* mouth *one* confesses unto salvation. Rom 10:11 For the Scripture says, "Everyone believing on Him shall not be put to shame." Rom 10:12 For there is no difference both of Jew and of Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call on Him. Rom 10:13 For everyone, "**whoever shall call on the name of the Lord (Jehovah/Jesus) will be saved.**" Rom 10:14 How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without preaching? **(This is quoted from Joel where the name Jehovah is used. In Romans 10 "the name "Jehovah" from Joel 2 is directly applied to Jesus – see also Acts 2:21-34)**

Jehovah returns to the earth after sun and the moon are darkened. Jesus is Jehovah

Joe 2:31 **The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood,** before the coming of the great and awesome day of Jehovah.

Isaiah 13:9-11 **Behold, the day of Jehovah/Yahweh is coming,** cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it. **10 For the stars of heaven and the constellations thereof shall not give their light: the sun shall be darkened in his going forth and the moon shall not cause her light to shine.** And I will punish the world for [their] evil, and the wicked for their iniquity;

Mat 24:29 And immediately after the tribulation of those days, **the sun shall be darkened and the moon shall not give her light,** and the stars shall fall from the heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken. 30 And then the sign of the Son of Man shall appear in the heavens. And then all the tribes of the earth shall mourn, and they shall see the Son of Man coming in the clouds of the heaven with power and great glory.

Rev 6:12 And when He had opened the sixth seal, I looked, and behold, there was a great earthquake. **And the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood.** 13 And the stars of heaven fell to the earth, even as a fig tree casts her untimely figs when she is shaken by a mighty wind. 14 And *the* heaven departed like a scroll when it is rolled together. And every mountain and island were moved out of their places 15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every freeman, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains. 16 And they said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us and hide us from *the* face of Him sitting on the throne, **and from the wrath of the Lamb; 17 for the great day of His wrath has come, and who will be able to stand?**

Mar 13:24 But in those days, after that tribulation, the **sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light,** 25 and the stars of Heaven shall fall, and the powers in the heavens shall be shaken. **26 And then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory.** 27 And then He shall send His angels and shall gather His elect from the four winds, from *the* end of *the* earth to *the* end of heaven.

Jehovah Returns To The Earth On The Mount Of Olives. Jesus Is Jehovah

Zec 14:3 And Jehovah shall go out and fight against those nations, like the day He fought in the day of battle. **4** And His feet shall stand in that day on the Mount of Olives, which *is* before Jerusalem on the east, and the Mount of Olives shall divide from its middle, from the east and to the west, a very great valley. And half of the mountain shall move toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

Act 1:9 And saying these things, *as* they watched, He was taken up. And a cloud received Him out of their sight. 10 And while they were looking intently into the heaven, He having gone, even behold, two men in

white clothing stood beside them, 11 who also said, Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into the heaven? **This same Jesus who is taken up from you into Heaven, will come in the way you have seen Him going into Heaven.** 12 **Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mount Of Olive Grove,** which is a sabbath day's *journey* from Jerusalem.

Jehovah is the first and the last. Jesus is Jehovah

Isa 44:6 So says Jehovah, the King of Israel, and His redeemer Jehovah of Hosts; **I am the first, and I am the last; and besides Me there is no God.**

Rev 1:17 And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. And He laid His right hand upon me, saying to me, Do not fear, **I am the First and the Last, 18 and the Living One, and I became dead, and behold, I am alive for ever and ever, Amen.** (See also Rev. 22:13)

Isaiah Chapters 40-48 contain the highest expression of monotheism to be found in the Old Testament. Read the following verses and see that the eternal Creator of the world, is repeatedly claiming here to be the only existing God.

Jehovah raised up John the Baptist to prepare the way of Jehovah. Jesus is Jehovah

Isa 40:3 The voice of him who cries in the wilderness, **Prepare the way of Jehovah,** make straight a highway in the desert for our God. 4 Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low; and the crooked places shall be made level, and the rough places smooth; 5 **and the glory of Jehovah shall be revealed,** and all flesh shall see *it* together; for the mouth of Jehovah has spoken.

Mat 3:1 In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, 2 and saying, Repent, for the kingdom of Heaven is at hand. 3 For this is he who was spoken of by the prophet Isaiah, saying, "The voice of *one* crying in the wilderness: **Prepare the way of the Lord, make His paths straight.**" (Question – Who showed up? Jesus. John prepared the way of Jesus)

Mal 3:1 Behold, I will send My messenger, **and He will clear the way before Me.** And Jehovah, whom you seek, shall suddenly come to His temple, even the Angel of the Covenant, in whom you delight. Behold, He comes, says Jehovah of Hosts.

Mat 11:10 For this is *the one* of whom it is written, "Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, who shall prepare Your way before You." 11 Truly I say to you, Among *those* who have been born of women there has not risen a greater one than John the Baptist. But the least in the kingdom of Heaven is greater than he.

Jehovah will not share His glory with another. Jesus is Jehovah.

Isa 42:8 I am Jehovah; that is My name; **and My glory I will not give to another,** nor My praise to graven images.

Joh 17:5 And now Father, **glorify Me with Yourself with the glory which I had with You before the world was.**

Rev 5:11 And I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, and the living creatures and the elders. And the number of them was myriads and myriads, and thousands of thousands, 12 saying with a great voice, **Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and blessing.** 13 And I heard every creature which is in the Heaven and on the earth, and under the earth, and those that are in the sea, and all who are in them,

saying, **Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him sitting on the throne, and to the Lamb forever and ever.**

2Pe 3:18 But grow in grace and *in* knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. **To Him be the glory,** both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.

Jehovah alone is God. Jesus is Jehovah

Isa 45:5 I am Jehovah, and there is none else, **no God besides Me;** I clothed you, though you have not known Me; **6** that they may know from the rising of the sun, and to the sunset, that there is none besides Me. I am Jehovah, and there is none else; **7** forming the light and creating darkness; making peace and creating trouble. I Jehovah do all these things.

Thomas called Jesus God

Joh 20:27 Then He said to Thomas, Reach your finger here and behold My hands; and reach your hand here and thrust *it* into My side; and do not be unbelieving, but believing. **28** And Thomas answered and said to Him, **My Lord and my God!**

Paul called Jesus God

Tit 2:11 For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, **12** teaching us that having denied ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live discreetly, righteously and godly, in this present world, **13** looking for the blessed hope, and the appearance of the **glory of our great God and Savior** Jesus Christ,

John called Jesus God

Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, **and the Word was God.** **2** The same was in the beginning with God. **3** All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made... Joh 1:14 And the **Word was made flesh,** and dwelt among us,

Rev 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him *was* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. **12** His eyes *were* as a flame of fire, and on his head *were* many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. **13** And he *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: **and his name is called The Word of God.**

God called Jesus God

Heb 1:8 But **unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever:** a sceptre of righteousness *is* the sceptre of thy kingdom. **9** You have loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; **therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee** with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

The Pharisees declared that Jesus was calling himself God

Joh 10:29 My Father who gave *them* to me is greater than all, and no one is able to pluck *them* out of My Father's hand. **30** I and the Father are one! **31** Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him. **32** Jesus answered them, I have shown you many good works from My Father; for which of these do you stone Me? **Joh 10:33** The Jews answered Him, saying, **We do not stone you for a good work, but for blasphemy, and because you, being a man, make yourself God.**

Jehovah is the only Savior. Jesus is Jehovah

Isa 45:20 Gather yourselves and come; draw near together, escaped ones of the nations; those who set up the wood of their graven image, **and those that pray to a god that cannot save.** They know nothing. **21** Declare and bring near; yea, let them take counsel together. Who has declared this of old? Who has told it from then? **Is it not I, Jehovah? And there is no other God besides Me; a just God and a Savior; there is none besides Me.** **22** Turn to Me, **and be saved, all the ends of the earth; for I am God, and there is no other.** **23** I have sworn by Myself, the word has gone out of My mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, that to **Me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.**

Mat 1:21 And she shall bear a son, and you shall call His name **JESUS**: for **He shall save His people** from their sins. (Jesus = Jehovah is salvation)

Act 5:29 And Peter and the apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men. **30** The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you killed and hanged on a tree. **31** This One God has exalted **to be a Ruler and Savior** to His right hand in order to give repentance and remission of sins to Israel.

Rom 14:10 But why do you judge your brother? Or also why do you despise your brother? **For all shall stand before the judgment seat of Christ.** Rom 14:11-12 For it is written: "As I live, says the **Lord** (Jehovah quoted from Is. 45), every knee shall bow to Me, and every tongue shall confess to God."

Php 2:9 Therefore God has highly exalted Him, and has given Him a name which is above every name, **10** that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of heavenly ones, and of earthly ones, and of ones under the earth; **11** and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is **Lord**, to the glory of God the Father.

Jehovah is from everlasting. Jesus is Jehovah

Psa 93:1 **Jehovah reigns**, He is clothed with majesty; **Jehovah is clothed with strength**. He clothed Himself and the world is established; it shall not be shaken. **2 Your throne is established of old; You are from everlasting.**

Mic 5:2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; **whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.** (A prophecy concerning Jesus being born in Bethlehem and his eternal nature)

Isa 9:6 For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given; and the government shall be on His shoulder; and His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, **The mighty God, The everlasting Father,** The Prince of Peace. (Another prophecy of Christ as to his deity and eternal nature)

1Ti 1:16 But for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first **Jesus Christ** might show forth all long-suffering, as a pattern to those being about to believe on Him to life everlasting. **1Ti 1:17 Now to the King eternal, immortal,** invisible, the only wise God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

Rev 22:12 And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to each according as his work is. Rev 22:13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the Ending, the First and the Last.

Jehovah is the "I AM". Jesus is Jehovah

Exo 3:13 And Moses said to God, Behold, when I come to the sons of Israel, and shall say to them, The God of your fathers has sent me to you, and they shall say to me, What is His name? What shall I say to them? Exo 3:14 **And God said to Moses, I AM THAT I AM.** And He said, So you shall say to the sons of Israel, **I AM** has sent me to you. **15** And God said to Moses again, You shall say this to the sons of Israel, **Jehovah the God of your fathers**, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is My name forever, and this is My title from generation to generation. (The very name "Jehovah" implies self existence, the one who is.)

Joh 18:4 Then Jesus, knowing all things that were coming upon Him, went out and said to them, Whom do you seek? **5** They answered Him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus said to them, **I AM!** And Judas who betrayed Him also stood with them. **6** Then as soon as He had said to them, **I AM,** they went backward and fell to the ground.

Joh 8:56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and He saw and was glad. 57 Then the Jews said to Him, You are not yet fifty years old, and have you seen Abraham? 58 Jesus said to them, Truly, truly, I say to you, Before Abraham came into being, **I AM!** 59 Then they took up stones to throw at Him. But Jesus hid Himself and went forth out of the temple, going through *the* midst of them, and passed on by.

There are around 13 “ I Am’s” of Jesus “I am the way, the truth, and the life...door...the bread of life...alpha and Omega...true vine...the son of God...light of the world...good shepherd...the resurrection...beginning and the end...root and offspring of David

Isaiah saw the Jehovah on His Throne. Jesus is Jehovah

“Adonai” is a common name for God in the Old Testament and is also translated into Lord in the English.

“In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord/Adonai sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. Above it stood the seraphim: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. And one cried unto another, and said, **Holy, holy, holy, is JEHOVAH (the LORD) of hosts:** the whole earth is full of his glory. And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke. Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: **for mine eyes have seen the King, JEHOVAH (the LORD) of hosts.**” (Isaiah 6:1-5).

Joh 12:37 **But though He had done so many miracles before them, yet they did not believe on Him,** 38 so that the saying of Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spoke, "Lord, who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed?" 39 Therefore they could not believe, because Isaiah said again, 40 "He has blinded their eyes and hardened their heart, so that they should not see with their eyes nor understand with their heart, and be converted, and I should heal them." **41 Isaiah said these things when he saw His glory and spoke of Him.** Joh 12:42 Still, however, even out of the rulers, many did believe on Him. But because of the Pharisees they did not confess, lest they should be put out of the synagogue;

Although Jesus had performed multiple miracles, John tells us that the people did not believe on Him. John then quotes passages from Isaiah from Isaiah 53:1 and 6:10.

Then John connects the prophecies of Isaiah to Jesus. “These things said Isaiah, when he saw his glory, and spake of him” (John 12:41). In other words, when Isaiah saw His, or Jehovah’s, glory. This takes us right back to Isaiah 6, when Isaiah saw Jehovah on the throne. It is clear that Isaiah had seen the King Jehovah of Hosts and John declares that Isaiah had seen Jesus the Christ in His glory.

Jesus is the Jehovah God of the Old Testament. He is not a created being like finite humans. Having faith in Jesus as Lord/Jehovah and Savior is the **only** way for us to be saved and have eternal life, as we are told in Acts 4:12: "Salvation is found in **no one else**, for there is **no other name** under heaven given to men by which we must be saved." The scriptures make it plain one must confess Jesus is Jehovah in order to be saved.

Rom 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 11 For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. 12 For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Act 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved...

Jehovah calms the sea. Jesus is Jehovah

Psa 89:8 O Jehovah, the God of Hosts, who *is* a strong Jehovah like You? And Your faithfulness is round about You? **9** You rule the raging of the sea; when its waves arise, You still them.

Mat 8:26 And He said to them, Why are you afraid, little-faiths? Then He arose and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm. **27** But the men marveled, saying, What kind of *man* is this, that even the winds and the sea obey him!

Jehovah gives to every man according to his works. Jesus is Jehovah

Jer 17:10 I Jehovah search the heart, I try the reins, even to give to each man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his doings.

Rev 2:23 And I (Jesus) will kill her children with death. And all the churches will know that I am He who searches the reins and hearts, and I will give to every one of you according to your works.

Conclusion – This scripture above should be sufficient to make a foundational case Jesus has the same names and titles as Jehovah; Old Testament passages about Jehovah are applied to Jesus; Jesus has attributes of Jehovah; Jesus does works of Jehovah; Jesus receives honor and worship due to Jehovah; and there are no valid objections to Jesus being Jehovah; therefore **Jesus is Jehovah**. Give Him Glory and honor due His name!
